CONCERNING THE EXEMPTION FOR AIRCRAFT CREW, PILOTS, PILOTS-INSTRUCTORS, INSTRUCTORS, EXAMINERS, MAINTENANCE SPECIALISTS, AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS, AERO-MEDICAL DOCTORS PERMITS, CERTIFICATES, LICENCES AND RATINGS, TRAININGS AND QUALIFICATION CHECKS.

Guided by Article 6 (3) (3) Aviation Law of the Republic of Lithuania, on 14 March 2020 the Government of the Republic of Lithuania adopted resolution No. 207 “On the declaration of quarantine in the territory of the Republic of Lithuania” and having regard to Regulation (EU) No. 2018/1139 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 July 2018 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing the European Aviation Safety Agency, amending the European Parliament and the Council Regulations (EB) No. 2111/2005, (EB) No. 1008/2008, (EU) No. 996/2010, (EU) No. 376/2014 and Directives 2014/30/EU and 2014/53/EU and repealing the European Parliament and the Council Regulations (EB) Nr.552/2004 and (EB) Nr.216/2008 and the Council Regulation (EEB) No.3922/91 (OL2018,L 212, p. 1) article 71 part 1, in order to stop the possible spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus infection):

1. I set up:

1.1 an exemption for extension of the duration for an additional 4 months, but not beyond July 31, 2020.:

1.1.1 for aircraft maintenance specialists licenses, issued under Commission Regulation (EU) No. 1321/2014 of 26 November 2014 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of the organizations and personnel involved in these tasks (OL 2014 L 362, p. 1) Annex III (Part 66);

1.1.2 for aircraft operators, engaged in commercial and commercial special flights pilots, for pilots-instructors, examiners licenses, permits and certificates, aero-medical examiners certificates, class 1 medical certificates and cabin crew attestation medical certificates, issued in Commission Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 of 3 November 2011 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to civil aviation aircrew (OL 2011 L 311, p. 1) Annex I (part FCL) and Annex IV (part MED) pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

1.1.3 for training and checking according to Commission Regulation (EU) No. 965/2012 of 5 October 2012 laying down the technical conditions and administrative procedures related to air operations (OL 2012 L 296, p. 1) Annex III (part ORO) and Annex V (part SPA) pursuant to Regulation (EC) No. 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

1.1.4 for records of air traffic controllers' licenses with an expiry date and certificates, including medical certificates, aero-medical examiners certificates according to the Commission Regulation (EU) No 2015/340 of 20 February 2015 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures relating to air traffic controllers' licences and certificates pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, amending Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 923/2012 and repealing Commission Regulation (EU) No 805/2011 (OL 2015 L 63, p.1) Annex I (part ATC), Annex IV (part ATCO.MED).

1.2 that this Order applies to the permits, certificates, licenses, and their records, training, and examinations referred to in paragraph 1.1 of this Order that expired after this Order came into force.

2. I delegate Civil Aviation Department to inform the European Commission, The European Aviation Safety Agency and other Member States of the European Union about the exemption referred to in paragraph 1.1 of this Order.
